1. Important Dates & Times

Edmonton Craft Beer Festival

- Dates
 - March 8 & 9, 2024
- Location
 - Edmonton Expo Center Halls B + C
- Set-Up
 - Thursday, March 7 1PM to 7PM
 - Friday, March 8 10AM to 3:30PM (vehicles must be removed by 2:30)
- Take-Down
 - Saturday, March 9 10PM to Midnight
 - All items must be removed from the venue immediately following the festival!
- Festival Hours
 - Session #1
 - Friday 5PM to 10PM
 - Session #2
 - Saturday Noon to 4:30PM
 - Session # 3
 - Saturday 5:30 to 10PM

Calgary International Beerfest

- Dates
 - May 3 & 4
- Location
 - BMO Center, Stampede Park Halls D,E,F



• Set-Up

- Thursday, May 2 1PM to 7PM
- Friday, May 3 10AM to 3:30PM
- Take-Down
 - Saturday, May 4 10PM to Midnight
 - All items must be removed from the venue immediately following the festival!

• Festival Hours

- Session #1
 - Friday 5PM to 10PM
- Session #2
 - Saturday 12PM to 4:30PM
- Session # 3
 - Saturday 5:30 to 10PM

2. What Does My Booth Space Include?

- Each non-sampling vendor will be provided with the following:
 - 10x10 Space (8' pipe & drape black background)
 - 1 x 8' table with covering and skirting
 - 4 x Exhibitor Passes / Session (Passes emailed approximately 1 week prior to each festival)
 - 10 x Promo Passes for Session #2 (Passes emailed approximately 1 month prior to each festival)
- Items that can be ordered through the venue:
 - Banner Hanging (from the ceiling)
 - Additional tables, chairs
- ABF will provide venue order forms for all additional products in updates leading up to the festival.

3. AGLC - Policies + Reminders

- No minors allowed in the venue this includes working at booths in any capacity!
- No consuming alcohol behind your booth for any reason.
- It is your responsibility to read and understand all AGLC Rules & Regulations prior to the event.



4. Fire Department - Policies + Reminders

- All canopies must be approved for indoor use.
 - ALL canopies must have a tag *(attached to the canopy)* clearly indicating that it is approved for indoor use and has a "SC-109" rating.
 - Be sure to have this confirmed prior to bringing your canopies to the festivals!
- All Display Vehicles
 - Must have less than ¼ of gas in the tank no exceptions!
 - Gas gauge must be functional.
- All food vendors must have a fire extinguisher at their booth!
